**About the Course:** 9th Radiology Resident's HOT SEAT Review Course is an exam-oriented comprehensive course for Radiology post-graduate students with multi-system, multi-modality course curriculum.

Demo sessions will cover 'Drugs & Devices in IR', 'Radiological Contrast Media', 'Conventional Contrast studies including Barium studies' and 'Radiography/Radiation Equipments'. The demo session on Contrast studies will specifically cover techniques and interpretation of BARIUM studies. 'Short teaching sessions' and 'Case-based reviews' will focus on important exam questions.

SPOTTERS sessions will be done in typical exams format with films displayed on the view-boxes and students will be able to individually attempt the spotters. Additional spotter sessions will be conducted on Power-point Slides as practice sessions.
